Re: Infringement of Copyright in Ladies' Home Journal

Dear Mr. Engel:

We are the attorneys for Meredith Corporation ("Meredith"), publisher of *Ladies' Home Journal*[®] magazine. It has come to our client's attention that materials that infringe Meredith's copyright in the July 2005 issue of *Ladies Home Journal*[®] have been posted at AbsoluteMadonna.com. The infringing materials comprise copies of numerous photographs of Madonna in which she has granted Meredith exclusive publishing rights. These materials constitute copyrighted works of original authorship and the posting of the works is an infringement of Meredith's exclusive rights under the Copyright Act and its license from Madonna.

The infringing materials are visible on the homepage of AbsoluteMadonna.com as well as in the latest news section. It is clear that you are aware that these photographs are protected by copyright and are subject to a press embargo. Indeed there is a posting in your AbsMad talk forum that references the embargo. You are listed as the administrator of the site and owner of the domain. Your posting of these images is a willful violation of copyright.

Accordingly, we hereby demand that you immediately remove the photographs from the website and cease all other uses, if any, of these copyrighted materials. Please be advised that the magazine is subject to a copyright registration and the infringement of this work may therefore subject you to statutory damages of up to \$150,000 as well as attorneys fees.

Our client takes this infringement seriously and will take all necessary steps to prevent further copyright infringement. Please confirm no later than June 6, 2005 that the infringing materials have been removed from the websites and that all infringing copies have been destroyed. In the interim, Meredith reserves all its rights in law and equity.
